2016 Year 11 External Examination Results Summary

The Department for Education has introduced a new measure for schools. Progress 8 measures a student's progress between Key Stage 2 and Key Stage 4 across eight key subjects. It shows whether students have performed to expectation, based on a value-added measure using Key Stage 2 English and Maths as a baseline. Attainment 8 measures a student's achievement across eight key subjects. The measure only takes account of GCSEs and a small number of vocational qualifications. They have to include mathematics (double weighted) and English (double weighted), 3 further qualifications that count in the English Baccalaureate (EBacc) measure and 3 further qualifications that can be GCSE qualifications (including EBacc subjects) or any other non-GCSE qualifications on the DfE approved list.

Whilst special schools are being included in the performance tables they do not have to meet the floor standard. In 2016 a mainstream school is below the floor standard if its Progress 8 score is below -0.5, and the upper band of the 95% confidence interval is below zero.

This is provisional data for 2016:

For Oakfield 20 out of the 21 learners in Year 11 were included in the measure. This includes our SLD learners whose qualifications do not count towards the measure, as well as those who did take GCSE qualifications.

The Progress 8 score for the school puts Oakfield in the top 3 percent of special schools nationally. This includes all the different types of school including pupil referral units, EBSD,

SEMH, MLD, autism, complex needs and all the differing cohorts of learners in these schools. A Progress 8 score of -1.34, although below the average score does demonstrate outstanding progress for our learners from their starting points compared to other special schools.

Key Stage 4 Results 2016

The total number of learners in year 11 in 2016 was 21. All learners achieve qualifications with

83% attaining success in at least one GCSE or equivalent subject.

Key Stage 5

Oakfield continues to offer a personalised curriculum at KS5 to give all learners the opportunity to gain accreditation. There continued a wide range of subjects offered to suit the ability and needs of each learner. There were 24 students who left key stage 5 last year. The number of subjects/ qualifications studied totalled 32 this year. Some new subjects were added, including additional NCFEs, ASDAN CoPE and Additional English Awards. The pathways that the learners follow allow them to access employment, training or further education where appropriate. Many of the qualifications gained have a vocational focus; however there is a continued focus on English and maths skills throughout college, as demonstrated in the functional skills and additional English results. All our leavers are are now either in further education or at a training provider pursuing a pathway for their future and one year 12 learner who left this year is now pursuing a career in the construction industry with a construction company in St. Helens.
