<p>To ensure all Y7 learners make progress in literacy and numeracy</p>	<p>To provide appropriate interventions and support in literacy and numeracy</p>	<p>Evidence indicates that one to one tuition can be effective, on average accelerating learning by approximately five additional months' progress. Short, regular sessions (about 30 minutes, 3-5 times a week) over a set period of time (6-12 weeks) appear to result in optimum impact. Where identified as being beneficial learners will be taught in small groups which enables the teacher to focus exclusively on a small number of learners</p>	<p>Data will indicate learners are making exceptional progress based on their starting points.
