We are hosting an online chat session for learners on zoom and you are invited!

This will be an opportunity for you to see your friends from school online and chat with them about what you are doing at home.

Oakfield High School will be hosting the session so if you have any questions you can ask them.

There are some guidelines for the chat to ensure everyone stays safe, just like when we talk about e-safety in our computing lessons.

- The session will be password protected so only those invited can join.
- Invitations will go out via e-mail to those with e-mail accounts held by Pastoral Managers.
- Only learners from Oakfield can be on the session. No other children are allowed to be in the background.
- When you join you must identify yourself with your name not (iPad/Samsung).
- There will be a waiting room to ensure we know who is entering into the chat.
- At the start of the chat everyone will be on mute so that we can ensure the guidelines are being followed and not be overwhelmed with noise all at the same time.
- Try to find a quiet space/room to control noise levels, be sensitive when others are speaking and try your best with turn taking.
